DID YOU KNOW?

The majority of Afrikans who were enslaved in South Carolina came from West Afrika. They were the people of the great empires of Ghana, Mali and Songhay. The empire of Ghana goes far back beyond its known records, which lists forty-four kings before the Christian era. This alone would extend Ghana's known history beyond the 25th Dynasty of Kemet (Egypt) when the last black Pharaohs ruled Kemet in the 7th century B.C. After repeated attacks by Muslims from the north, Ghana finally lost power to the empire of Mali in the 13th century. Mali was founded by the Mandingo people, and within 100 years it was a great empire. It covered what is today called Gambia, Guinea, Senegal, Mali and Mauritania. Mansa Musa was one of Mali's greatest kings.

Mali survived until the 1500's. It fell to the kingdom of Songhay, which had its power base in Timbuktu on the River Niger. Songhay was even larger than Mali, stretching from the Atlantic coast westward to what is today central Nigeria. In the 1400s the city of Timbuktu was home to one of the world's greatest universities, the University of Sankore. This was during the time when Europe was living through the dark ages and all light of civilization was extinguished.

Internal strife and outside pressures eventually splintered the Songhay empire into smaller kingdoms. No West Afrikan empire replaced it before the coming of the Europeans who began kidnapping, enslaving and shipping them into South Carolina.

If you trace generational roots to South Carolina, many of us are the descendants of those West Afrikans, and most importantly, the greatness which flowed within them to be the light of the world, also flows within each of us. There is no new blood. From the unification of their blood through the sperm and egg, a blood clot was formed and became our forbearers. From our forbearers to our mother and father, and on into our children the future of us as a people. One drop of blood with no traceable beginning and no discernible end.

Understanding's Legal Corner

One of the most frightening and difficult situations we as people face in this society, is if we are arrested and taken in by the police for questioning and/or arrested.

When you are taken in for questioning or arrested the main thing to always remember is to answer no questions and make no statements. The first thing you must do is request a lawyer, and if possible, do this in front of anyone who can hear you. This way if you are denied a lawyer and they question you without one, you have a witness to testify to the fact that you did indeed ask for a lawyer. When you are asked questions by the police, it is your right to not answer their questions, and if they try to make you answer, ask for a lawyer. Once taken in for questioning or arrested, they have to read you your Miranda Rights. They have to verbally say to you:

"You have the right to remain silent. Anything you say can and will be used against you in a court of law. You have the right to talk to an attorney. If you cannot afford an attorney one will be appointed to represent you. Do you understand these rights?" If these rights are not verbally read to you upon arrest and/or before questioning, anything you say cannot be used against you in a court of law. Now this does not mean you start telling everything you know. This is how many make their predicament worse, by simply talking to much. The police practice a form of psychological interrogation where they have a seemingly innocent conversation with you about any and everything. This is to put you at ease and get you comfortable with talking. Then they start to weave in certain questions, which you subconsciously think its part of the same innocent conversation you was having. Its trick-knowledge at its best. If you are not consciously aware, they will have you saying things which they will use to ultimately arrest and convict you...continued on next page.

...Another devious tactic they use is play on your self preservation instinct by telling you that someone else, a friend, has already given them a statement saying you did so and so. They think you will automatically begin to defend yourself and let something incriminating slip. What many people don't know is that the police can legally lie to in an interrogation, especially when they have nothing but a suspicion. So many have told on themselves and others without even knowing until it's too late. By knowing their tactics, we can overcome them, if we find ourselves being questioned by the police.

Under the Fifth Amendment to the U.S. Constitution, we have the right not to be forced to give any statement we do not want to. You do not have to say anything. Just ask for a lawyer. If you should find yourself taken in by the police, ask them if you are being arrested. If they say no, then tell them you wish to leave. They cannot hold you if you are not being arrested. If they say they are holding you on suspicion, ask them what is the suspicion and what is their probable cause. If they hold you without cause and without arrest, then they are holding you against your will, which is false imprisonment. Then you have a lawsuit against them for money.

If we all become aware of our rights, many of the situations we find ourselves in can be avoided or dealt with ease. If you learn and understand what you must do to legally protect yourself, if you should happen to find yourself in police custody, you can save yourself a lot of aggravation and even time in jail and/or prison. In sum, an individual who does not know how to legally protect himself, will always fall victim to the devious tactics practiced by the many law enforcement entities of this society in which we presently live.
